



Diplomate Recertification Fees

Recertification Fees:

- Maintain active NCCAOM status—recertify every 4 years \$230
- Move from active to inactive NCCAOM status \$ 75
- Convert from AC and/or CH to Oriental Medicine \$460
- Move from lapsed to active NCCAOM status Varies

Fees for Overlapping Certification (Optional)

For Diplomates originally certified in Acupuncture and/or Chinese Herbology only, who converted to Oriental Medicine certification, NCCAOM offers recertification in Acupuncture and/or Chinese Herbology.

Overlapping recertification in Acupuncture \$100

(Expiration date for Acupuncture Certification will coincide with the Oriental Medicine Certification expiration date)

Overlapping recertification in Chinese Herbology \$100

(Expiration date for Chinese Herbology Certification will coincide with the Oriental Medicine Certification expiration date)

Note: The purchase of overlapping certifications is not a requirement. Only certification in Oriental Medicine must be maintained.
